

AXIOMS: You Reap What You Sew

Often, God weaves into the visible world realities that **MIRROR** the big truths of the invisible, spiritual world.

Galatians 6

7Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. 8The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature will reap destruction; the one who sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. 9Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.

THE DOWNSIDE

Self-deception is **RAMPANT**.

We believe that we will be the **EXCEPTION TO THE RULE**.

The **DELAY** of the harvest fools us into believing that we have beaten the odds.

We are **SHOCKED** when we experience the unavoidable fruit of our seed-sowing.

THE UPSIDE

There is another **BUCKET OF SEED** available to us.

The AXIOM that you and I reap what we sow can work **IN OUR FAVOR**.

The farmer does not haphazardly sow; he makes plans to **MAXIMIZE** the harvest.

So a lot, reap **A LOT** more.

1. We want to harvest the **SAME DAY** as we sow.
Is it not working or is it not time?
2. God is working to **DEVELOP** the sower.
Are we seeking God or simply His stuff.
3. We are reaping what **OTHERS** have sown.
