Forgiveness is Not:

- 1. Forgetting
- 2. Waiting For An Apology
- 3. Ceasing To Feel Pain
- 4. A One-Time Event
- 5. Trusting

Trust is all about the other person and time.

Trust has to be earned over time through the acts that follow repentance.

6. Reconciliation Forgiveness puts aside all bitterness and all plans for revenge.

In reconciliation, both parties actively work to repair the breach.

Romans 12:8 As far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.

Romans 12:19 Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to revenge; I will repay," say the Lord.

Time does not heal all wounds.

Passage of time does not produce maturity relationally, emotionally, or spiritually. Time with the Lord can lead to all wounds being healed.
